Channel Low Iron Silvered Glass, part of Nathan Allan's exclusive Freeform Series, is exciting, new, and the first "texture less" kiln formed glass in our industry. Designed for architects and interior designers who prefer a structured linear glass pattern for their projects. Our Channel Low Iron Silvered texture has tight, 5/8" (15mm) wide, protruding Convex shaped flutes. The protruding pattern creates a 3D surface effect. Illuminating this 3D effect is the Silvered (Mirror) finish applied to the back surface. The Channel Low Iron Silvered finish reflects light and highlights the Fluted texture to another level. Ideal for all cladding applications where the glass can be pressed against another wall surface, to hide or block the surface. A perfect application for our Channel Low Iron Silvered glass is the back wall of any hotel registration area or entrance lobby. Also, apply our Silvered glass options to make a simple column become bold and vibrant.

Pattern Details	Individual Flutes are 5/8" (15mm) wide. Back surface is flat. Flutes can run in vertical or horizontal direction.
